4.0 ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

4.1 Postgraduate Degree Programmes

- a) M.A Guidance & Counselling
A Second Class Lower Division or better in any discipline, apart from Psychology, from a recognized university.
- b) M.A in Small Business Management
 - A Second Class Lower Division or better in any discipline from a recognized university OR.
 - A Third Class with a minimum of one year's work experience.
- c) M.Phil Statistics
A Second Class Lower Division or better in Statistics from a recognized university.
- d) M.Phil Guidance & Counselling
A Second Class Lower Division or better in B.A Psychology, B.Ed Psychology (or their equivalents), or B.A Social Work.
- e) MBA
A Second Class Lower Division or better from a recognized university with post-qualification experience.

4.2 Bachelor's Degree Programmes

- i. SSSCE Certificate Holders:
Credit passes (A-D) in three (3) Core subjects including English, Mathematics and Integrated Science or Social Studies; plus Credit Passes (A-D) in any three (3) elective subjects.
- ii. WASSCE Certificate Holders:
Credit Passes(A1-C6) in three Core subjects including English, Mathematics and Integrated Science or Social Studies, plus credit passes (A1-C6) in any three (3) elective subjects.

The aggregate score for the Core and elective subjects must not exceed 24 for SSSCE candidates and 36 for WASSCE candidates.

iii. ABCE Holders

Passes in three (3) subjects, one of which should be at least grade "D" or better in the Advanced Business Certificate Examinations (ABCE). Also credit passes in five (5) subjects including English, Mathematics and Integrated Science or Social Studies in the General Business Certificated Examinations (GBCE).

iv. Other applicants with:

- HND(Higher National Diploma)
- Diploma from recognised universities
- Mature Applicants

4.3 Diploma Programmes (2 yrs Duration)

4.3.1 Terminal Diploma in Information Technology:

- SSSCE: Six (6) Passes A-D in all subjects including English and Mathematics
- WASSCE: Six (6) Passes(A1-D7) (must include three (3) credit passes)

4.3.2 Continuing Dip in Information Technology:

C6 or better for WASSCE, D or better for SSSCE in three (3) Core subjects (including English & Mathematics), and two (2) credit passes in any relevant electives.

4.3.3 Diploma in General Nursing (2 yrs duration)

SSSCE/WASSCE Applicants: Credit Passes (A-D) or (A1-C6) in 6 subjects comprising 3 Core subjects which include English and Mathematics, plus 3 elective subjects.
